001	Insertion of implantable heart assist system or implantation of total internal biventricular heart replacement system	02HA[0,3,4]QZ	Review operative report carefully to determine extent of all procedures. Implantable ventricular assist devices are attached to the native heart. A total artificial heart (TAH) is an implantable biventricular support device that serves as a total replacement for both ventricles of the failing heart.

	Insertion of external heart assist system with removal of existing heart assist system (e.g. replacement, exchange)	02HA[0,4]R[S,Z] 02HA3RS AND 02PA[0,3,4]RZ	Both codes must be reported. Review operative report carefully to determine extent of all procedures. External (sometimes called Percutaneous ventricular assist devices (pVADs) are generally placed through the femoral artery via catheter. Both insertion and removal must be performed.

	Removal and revision of heart assist system	02WA[0,3,4][Q,R]Z AND 02PA[0,3,4]RZ	Both codes must be reported. Root operation "Revision" is correcting, to the extent possible, a portion of a malfunctioning device or the position of a displaced device. Removal must be performed in conjunction with revision.

260	Cardiac pacemaker revision procedure	0JWT0PZ 0JWT3PZ	Root operation "Revision" is defined as: "Correcting, to the extent possible, a malfunctioning or displaced device" and is coded when the objective of the procedure is to correct the position or function of a previously placed device, without taking the entire device out and putting in a whole new device in its place. Revision can include correcting a malfunctioning device by taking out and/or putting in part, but not all, of the device. Example of pacemaker revision would be adjustment of the position of pacemaker lead without removing or replacing the lead.
